SWIMMING POOLS:
ALL swimming pools intended for swimming, recreational bathing or wading which contain or are designed to contain water over 24” deep require issuance of a Zoning and Building permit and must meet specific NYS Dept. of State Uniform Building Code Pool safety laws and requirements addressing pool alarms, lockable gates, and other restrictive items. Complete information will be provided during the permit issuance. These laws include in-ground, above-ground, on ground, indoor pools and hot tubs.

ANNUAL OPEN BURNING BAN: March 16 to May 14

The NYS Dept. of Environmental Conservation prohibits open burning of residential waste in ALL communities statewide, regardless of population with certain exceptions for burning tree limbs and branches at limited times and other circumstances.

RECYCLING AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

GARBAGE

Curbside pickup once a week. Each household is allowed 4 containers with a total weight of 60 lbs. ALL garbage must be in approved 30 gal. or less plastic bags.

***No fluorescent bulbs accepted

***Items should be out by 6:00 am on the scheduled day.

NEEDLES/SYRINGES:

DO NOT SET OUT WITH RECYCLABLES

Place used needles/syringes in a coffee can with a lid, or a plastic bottle with a top. When full, tape lid shut, label as “SHARPS” and discard in the garbage.

ABSOLUTELY NO bulk trash or construction debris on curbside.

RECYCLABLES

ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE DEBAGGED.

Curbside pickup once a week (Same day as your scheduled garbage day.) Recyclables (paper, glass, aluminum, metal), may be placed in one container. A plastic garbage can no larger than 35 gal., must be used. Labels can be picked up at the Town Hall.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED AND TIED IN BUNDLES NO LARGER THAN 2’ X 2’ X 2’.
BULK TRASH AND CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS ACCEPTED AT Transfer Station next to Highway Garage, Camroden Rd. on the scheduled days. Only One (1) PICKUP truck load per person each day.
ABSOLUTELY NO CONTRACTOR DEBRIS. Large projects must hire dumpster service.

DRIVER’S LICENSE WILL BE CHECKED FOR PROOF OF RESIDENCY.

Bulk trash **MUST** be generated in the Town of Floyd. A nominal fee is charged for tires. Refrigerators, air conditioners, and recyclable electronics are now accepted without cost.

**NONE of the following: LP Tanks, batteries, or used oil.
